The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) helps low-income people meet their energy needs. Apply for LIHEAP through May 31st, 2020. YOU DO NOT NEED A DISCONNECT NOTICE TO APPLY

The Energy Crisis Intervention Program (ECIP) can help you pay your utility bills when they are shut off or in current threat of being shut-off. The amount is based on the amount of money needed to settle your crisis with the energy provider.

WINTER HELP is available November-May based on funding; the maximum amount you can receive is \$800 for both your primary and secondary utility sources that are shut off or in threat of being shut off (Natural Gas, Propane, Electricity, and Wood)

Monthly Income

Qualifications based on income eligibility – Income adjustments may be made based on special circumstances such as loss of job, furloughed employee, etc. ASK for details.


Maximum Income Guidelines:
